II. Confessing our sins (v. 8-10)

Six encouragements for confession: By confessing our sins...

- 1. We do not align ourselves with liars (v. 6, 8, 10)
- 2. We do not deceive ourselves (v. 8)
- 3. We glorify God's faithfulness and righteousness (v. 9)
- 4. We will experience God's forgiveness (v. 9)
- 5. We will experience God's cleansing (v. 9)
- 6. We are not opposing God and His word (v. 10)
